

Volunteer Report for Bromyard Downs Committee Association

June 2022 to June 2023

There have been approximately 35 working parties in the last year with an average of between 5 to 11 volunteers at each one.

Areas Covered

- Clearing paths across the racecourse
- Wide areas flailed to open up certain areas working from Muddy Lane across
- towards the Malvern Road and up to Brockhampton school

- The course for the Downs race cleared and cut back.
- Pot holes filled in the car park and over hanging trees cleared to allow access

- Removing damaged trees and cutting back those suffering from ash die back
- Painting the Jubilee bench
- Repair notice boards on Downs car park, by Brockhampton school and at the bottom of Burying Lane
- Tidying up any broken trees due to storm damage
- Repair and replace barriers in the car park.
- Strimming picnic areas and repairing benches.
- Clearing areas around the ponds

- Flailing large areas to provide wildlife corridors as per management plan
- Litter picking event for the Kings coronation.

- Regular litter picking by the volunteers as well as local residents and the wider community including taking it away.
- Maintaining and checking of chainsaws, tractor, and other equipment
